Putting a nutritious, quick dinner on the table has become a challenge for everyone. Especially for families where both husband and wife work and kids are involved in lots of activities.

A crock pot can get good food on the table in a short time. Food cooks at a low heat for long periods of time and you just need to add a vegetable, salad or bread for your meal.

Some need to know tips:

When you cook on low, the setting "When you cook on low, the setting take" 200 degrees F. Low usually take 2 grees F. bell may caramelize some foods and dry them out.

\* Temperature must be maintained at 158 degrees F for one hour to kill bacteria.

Try this recipe for a crock pot dessert:

Judy's Triple Chocolate Surprise 1 package chocolate cake mix 8 oz. sour cream 1 small pkg. chocolate pudding mix 1 cup chocolate chips 3/4 cup oil 4 eggs

4 eggs
3 cugbyater
Spray 2 ½ quart crock pot with non-stric cooking spray. Mix cake mix, sour cream, pudding mix, chocolate chips, oil, eggs and water by hand. Pour into crock pot. Cover and cook on low for 6-8 hours or high for 3-4 hours. Serve warm with ice crawm, whitipped cream or chocolate syrup.

with Urea when the N is applied, the greater the risk for volatilization loss of N. When surface-applied to bare soil and worked in, there is little risk unless soil pH is above 6.5. When surface applied to no-till corn, the

sariace appried to no-int corts, the risk can vary from great where there are enough residues to prevent much soil contact, to slight where residues are thin enough that most of the N contact the soil. When top-dressed onto grass so dwhere there is little initial contact with soil, risk is great after mid-sprine.

\*\*Effect of Sali pH - This has little effect on Nos except where Urea is spread onto hare soil and not worked in. Under such conditions, risk of volatilization can be great is surface pH of soil is above 6.5.

If using starter fertilizers which have been blended using Urea, do not place the fertilizer in contact with seed since concentration of ammonia resulting from urea such soil to the contact of the seed of per ton of material; ammonium intrate (33.5%) contains 667 pounds actual N per ton of material. Carefully consider the price per pound of actual N together with convenience in application and the relative risk of N toss for the source of N is best for you.

Keep in mind that Urea is the best buy at this time. Also keep in mind that most fertilizer like 19-19-19 is mixed with Urea as nitrogen source. Pesticide Training:


