

CAP receives donation

The Christian Appalachian Project received a truckload of insulation which will help insulate approximately 10 homes for very low income families in the Appalachian region - mostly in Kentucky and Tennessee. Owens Corning donated the insulation, valued at approximately \$16,000 through Gifts In Kind International.

CAP is an interdenominational, non-profit service organization committed to serving the people of Appalachia by providing physical, spiritual and emotional support through education, crisis intervention and community development. With more than seventy programs and services, CAP's efforts reach people through the thirteen Appalachian states.

"Many homes down here are without adequate insulation and this donation of insulation will allow us to fix that problem in some of the homes," said Jeff Burchette, procurement coordinator for CAP. "We're just starting a new program to build new houses in this area, plus we've had a home repair program for awhile and the insulation will go toward both projects." The donated insulation will help reduce costs for CAP.

"There's a lot of need out there," said Susan Corrigan, Gifts In Kind's president and chief executive officer. "But thanks to the generosity of donor companies like Owens Corning and the dedication of groups like the Christian Appalachian Project, we are helping provide resources to build decent, affordable housing for needy families. When you can leave your office at night and know that today you helped someone in need - that's a good day."

Gifts In Kind International (www.giftsinkind.org) partners with businesses and charities to provide

quality products and services that improves lives in communities around the world. Gifts In Kind International designs and manages corporate donation programs, such as this one for Owens Corning. Gifts In Kind distributes donated products to a network of 50,000 charities, including for the Christian Appalachian Project.

In 1999 alone, Gifts In Kind distributed over \$350 million in donated products, including computers, software, office equipment and supplies, clothing, personal care projects, recreational equipment, educational materials, arts and crafts supplies, and building materials. Qualified 501 (c) (3) organizations register with Gifts In Kind International to receive ac-

cess to donated products and services. Nonprofit organizations pay an annual registration fee to Gifts In Kind and receive a monthly catalog of available products and a weekly fax update highlighting the latest donations. All products are free; registered charities pay only a nominal administrative fee to cover shipping and handling (annually, administrative fees average less than one percent of the fair market value of products donated.)

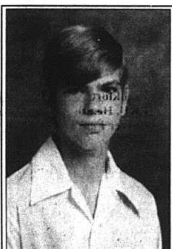
