oners but the Judge said that was not to keep the prisoners in but "the vandals out."

Jailer Miller said he was also working on three or four alternatives for food service to the prisoners and would use whichever was most cost efficient for the county. "We could build a kitchen down there, but it may be more cost efficient to contract with a local restaurant to provide the meals or we could cook the meals at the Detention Center and use hot plates to warm them up at the facility in Livingston," Miller said.

Another aspect of the project would be converting the current 22 minimum security beds in the county jail to maximum security beds. Carlotis and Miller said they were in the process of obtaining a cost estimate for that, but that too should be relatively inexpensive compared to the income the beds would generate. In February alone, the county was

paid approximately \$100,000 for keeping state prisoners in the county jail. Currently, the state pays \$26 per day for those prisoners, the same amount they would be paid for the work release prisoners housed at Livingston.

"The good thing about the project is that we can do it ourselves and not depend on some grant coming through from the state or federal government," Carlotis said. "I simply think it would be a good project for Livingston and for the county. We can begin renovating that property and we can pump more money into the county's economy," Carlotis said.

Currently, the Judge said there are no plans for the old main building on the Livingston School property. "We will look at our options for that building later, provided this first project is approved, which will be totally up to the magistrates and myself," the judge said.

Rockcastle awarded federal funds

Rockcastle County has been chosen to receive \$4,339,000 to supplement emergency food and shelter programs in the county.

The selection was made by a National Board that is chaired by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and consists of representatives from The Salvation Army, American Red Cross, United Jewish Communities, Catholic Charities, USA, National Council of the Churches of Christ in the U.S.A. and United Way of America which will provide the administrative staff and function as fiscal agent. The board was charged to distribute funds appropriated by Congress to help expand the capacity of food and shelter programs in high-need areas around the county.

A local board made up of a representative from Rockcastle County Judge Executive's office, Daniel Boone Development Council, etc., will determine how the funds awarded to Rockcastle are to be distributed among the emergency food and shelter programs run by local service

organizations in the area. The local board is responsible for recommending agencies to receive these funds and any additional funds available under this phase of the program.

Under the terms of the grant from the National Board, local organizations chosen to receive funds must: 1) be private voluntary nonprofits or units of government; 2) have an accounting system; 3) practice nondiscrimination; 4) have demonstrated the capability to deliver emergency food, and/or shelter programs; and 5) if they are a private voluntary organization, they must have a voluntary board. Qualifying organizations are urged to apply.

Rockcastle County has distributed Emergency Food and Shelter funds previously with Daniel Boone Development and REAP. These agencies were responsible for providing 8600 meals and 154 nights of lodging.

The deadline for applications is April 3rd, 2000.
