The major hitch in the entire case came when Mrs. Lovell supposedly fired her attorney Mark Stanziano of Somerset so she could talk to Venters and Montgomery. Lovell's attorney Mark Stanziano filed motions to have Judge Venters and Montgomery kicked off the case, because Stanziano said the two violated Lovell's rights when they talked to her without an attorney.

Stanziano lost both motions and appealed to Kentucky Chief Justice Joe Lambert who ruled in favor of Venters and Montgomery.
