second place finish. In the process, they defeated rival Dunbar by three points. Top ranked Bishop Brossart, an all-girl private school boasting over 50 high school runners and three winners, placed first.

Cheyenne Carmack, had an outstanding meet and earned the girls' MVP award for being the leading female scorer. Cheyenne finished with 27.25 total points. In the 100-meter dash, Cheyenne sprinted to a second place finish in 13.4. In the 200-meter dash, Cheyenne ran an awesome race and finished second with an excellent time of 27.2. Both the 100 and 200 were literally photo finishes. Cheyenne's best performance came in the 400-meter dash.

Cheyenne powered her way to a first place finish with the most amazing 400-meter race of her career. She finished with a new RCHS and Pulaski County Invitational record time of 59.39. This broke the mark she established at last year's meet by nearly four-tenths of a second.

Rachelle Hammond was close behind in the scoring and had many awesome performances. In long jump, Rachelle capped an impressive 15'6" and placed second. Her most amazing performance came in the triple jump competition. With the meet on the line and the girls' team trailing Dunbar by four points, Rachelle executed the greatest jump in RCHS history. On her final attempt, she leaped her way to a first place finish and moved the team ahead of Dunbar. Her effort of 34'2" established a new RCHS record and moved her

into fourth place in the Class 2A state rankings. Rachelle also placed eighth in the 400-meter dash with an effort of 1:05.4.

Sophomore thrower Clarissa Hubbard was third in scoring for the meet. She dominated her events once again and easily captured first place in both shot put and discus. In shot, Clarissa threw an impressive 101'11.75". In discus, she threw of 325'6" was over 23' farther than her nearest competitor.

Teammate Ashley Lawson had her best meet ever. In shot put, Ashley threw a personal best 26'7.75" and placed third overall. In discus, Ashley also had one of her best performances over and finished fifth with an effort of 77'7".

Tara Abney continued her excellence in the hurdles. In the 100-meter hurdles, Tara ran a great race and despite knocking over the last six hurdles, finished second overall with a time of 17.24. In the 300-meter hurdles, Tara ran one of her best times of the season and finished sixth overall in 52.1.

Theresa Chistum also ran well in the hurdles. In the 100-hurdles, Theresa finished eighth with a time of 18.3. In the 300-hurdles, Theresa placed 10th in 56.1.

Chere' Embke performed well in the high jump competition. She placed third overall with an awesome effort of 4'10". Teammate Heather Hammond also jumped well and placed 10th with a leap of 4'6".

Chere' Embke leaped to a personal best in the triple jump competition. She placed ninth overall with an impressive effort of 30'1".

In the 400-meter relay, Theresa, Mindy, Casey Taylor and Chere' finished sixth with an impressive time of 56.7.

In the 800-meter relay, Tara, Chere', Casey and Heather ran a great race and placed fourth overall in 1:56.9.

The 1600-meter relay team of Cheyenne, Tara, Rachelle and Theresa ran an awesome race and finished fourth in 4:25.7.

The 3200-meter relay team of Jessica Asher, Kayla Hayes, Makayla Bryant and Danielle Arnold ran their best time ever and finished seventh in 11:27.8.

Sixth grader Mournie Ramsey continues to improve in her events. In the 1600-meter run, Mournie ran her fastest time ever and finished 16th in 6:25.4. In the 3200-meter run, she also ran fast and finished 12th with a personal record time of 14:12.8.

In the 800-meter run, Jessica Asher and Kayla Hayes continued to show their consistency. Jessica ran a great meet, finished 11th in 2:45.2. Kayla was close behind with an excellent performance and placed 12th in 2:45.5.

The boys' team placed 12th overall and had many outstanding performances.

Junior Eric Denney threw very well in the discus competition. He finished third overall with a very impressive throw of 119'5". In shot put, Eric had his best performance ever. He threw an amazing 40'11.5" and placed fifth overall.

Senior Dustin Crawford, ran very well in the 100-meter dash. Dustin sprinted to a photo finish with an awesome time of 11.6. In the 200, Dustin has ran extremely well and finished sixth in his second best performance ever. He finished with an amazing time of 23.9. Dustin's most awesome performance came in the 300-meter hurdles, an event he had tried only once before in practice. Despite his lack of experience, Dustin blazed his way to a third place finish with an unbelievable time of 44.8.

Sophomore Josh Hale ran his greatest time ever in the 100-meter dash. Josh sprinted to a personal best time of 11.8 and finished 10th. In the

In the 400-meter run, Stewart Abney had an outstanding race. Stewart placed 11th overall with a time of 59.5.

Eighth grader Steven Shackelford ran a great 300-meter hurdle race. Steven placed 13th in 51.8. In high jump, Steven placed eighth with an impressive effort of 4'10". In long jump, he placed 13th with a leap of 13'4.5".

In the 800-meter run, Matt and Brandon ran great races. Matt finished 17th with an impressive time of 2:34.5. Brandon was very close behind with an equally impressive time of 2:34.9. He placed 18th overall.

In the 3200-meter run, Bill Burdett ran very well and finished 16th overall in 12:56.2.
