Minor Damage to Tobacco

By: Tom Mills County Extension Agent for Agriculture "Sneaky" Pests Can Cause

Budworms are "sneaky" pests nose undetected feeding often uses serious damage to tobacco ants during this part of the growing ason. Typical transplant water secticide treatments will run out at

droppings, resembling ground pepper, that collect on the leaves. Budworm damage can be reduced with properly timed insecticidal sprays.

# time feeding holes become obvious, most of the harm has been done. Budworms are a wide spread problem. Early detection and through spray coverage are essential to limiting condange. At weekly intervals, check the bud area of plants for small feeding holes on the leaves and small black insect droponines. resembling erround
