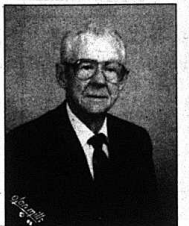


Obituaries

Active pallbearers were Tommy Payne, Louie McCall, Bobby Turpin, Richie Bray, Roger Bray and Ronnie Bray.

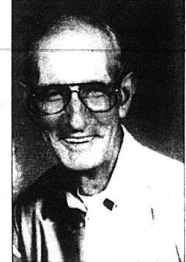
