"Both of those cars drove off af-ter the wreck and the only eyewit-nesses left at the scene were behind

the Henry vehicle.

Kyle Rader was welaring a seat belt and received minor injuries, but his Dad was not wearing a seat belt and the Saturn did not have airbags. Calvin Rader, died a very short time a fler being taken to the Rockeastle Hospital.
