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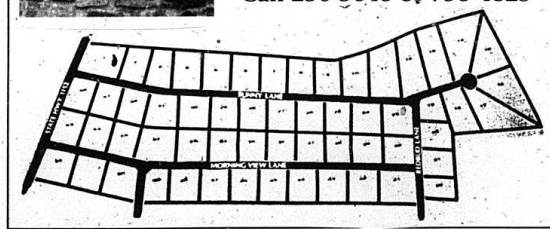

The purpose of this meeting is to inform the public of the planning study, discuss various environmental and technical issues concerning the area under consideration, and solicit ideas and opinions that will help the Cabinet make decisions about the study. Anyone having an interest in this planning study is urged to attend this meeting.

This will be an open public meeting with a brief presentation at 6 p.m., followed by an informal discussion session and an exhibit area where officials will be prepared to answer questions and/or receive public input.

Maps and tables describing the various alternatives and their potential impacts will be available for viewing at the meeting. They will also be available for viewing from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. local time for fifteen (15) days after the meeting at the Kentucky Department of Highways District 8 Office, US 27, Somerset, Kentucky.

Both written and oral statements will be accepted at the meeting. A recorder will be made available to those who desire to make oral statements at a comment sheet will be distributed to make it more convenient to provide written comments. Written statements will be accepted at the meeting and for a period of fifteen (15) days after the Public Information meeting. Written statements should be addressed to Annette Coffey, P.E., Director, Division of Planning, 125 Holmes Street, Frankfort, Kentucky 40622, or returned using the postage-paid comment sheet. All recorded and written statements will become part of the official record. Once compiled, the summary of this meeting and other supporting documentation will be made available for review and copying only after an Open Records Request has been received and approved. All Open Records requests must be submitted to the Transportation Cabinet, Department of Administrative Services, State Office Building, Frankfort, Kentucky 40622.
