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## Public Notification Monitoring Violations

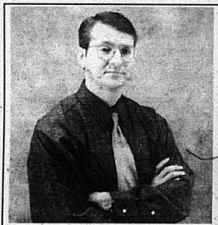
The Broadhead Water Works hereby gives notice that during the time period of July 1, 1993 through December 31, 1993, and January 1, 1995 through December 31, 1995, the water system failed to comply with certain monitoring and reporting as required by 401 KAR 8:010 through 9:700 inclusive.

The specific violations to the time period are: failure to submit adequate number of analytical results for lead and copper for the monitoring period July 1, 1993 through December 31, 1993 and failure to submit adequate number of analytical results for lead and copper for the reduced monitoring period January 1, 1995 through December 31, 1995.

Any potential adverse health effects to any segments of the population could not be determined due to failure to comply with the monitoring requirements.

In most cases, monitoring violations do not require the public to seek alternative water supplies or take preventive measures. If alternative water supplies or preventive measures are needed, the public shall be notified immediately.
