



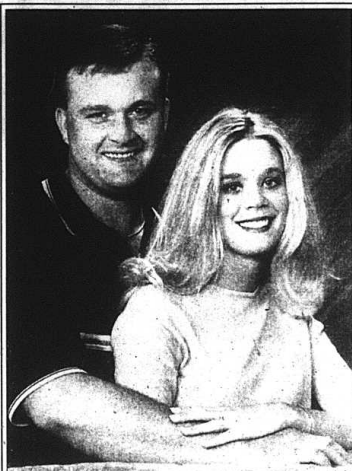
### Fordyce - Wyatt wed

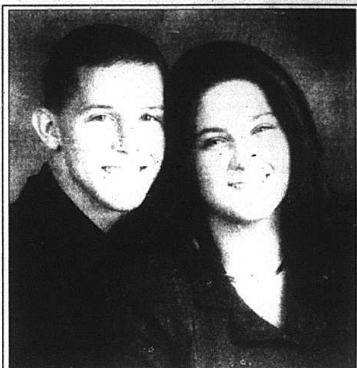
### Cummins - Scoggin
