#### ROCKCASTLE COUNTY HAS BEEN AWARDED FEDERAL FUNDS UNDER THE EMERGENCY FOOD AND SHELTER NATIONAL BOARD PROGRAM.

Rockcastle County has been chosen to receive \$8,099.00 to supplement food and shelter programs in the county

The selection was made by a National Board that is chaired by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and con-sists of representatives from The Salvation Army, American Red Cross, United Jewish Communities, Catholic Charties, USA, Na-tional Council of the Churches of Christ in the USA and United Way of American which will provide the administrative staff and function as fiscal agent. The Board was charged to distribute funds appropriated by Congress to help expand the capacity of food and shelter programs in high-need areas around the country.

A Local Board made up of a representative from Rockcastle County Judge Executive's office, Daniel Boone Development Council, etc. will determine how the funds awarded to Rockcastle are to be distributed among the emergency food and shelter programs run by local service organizations in the area. The Local Board is responsible for recommending agencies to receive these funds and any additional funds available under this phase of the program.

Under the terms of the grant from the National Board, Local orga-Under the terms of the grant from the National Board, Local organizations chosen to receive funds must 1) be private voluntary nonprofits or units of government, 2) have an accounting system, 3) practice nondiscrimination, 4) have demonstrated the capability to deliver emergency food and or shelter programs, and 5) if they are a private voluntary organization, they must have a voluntary board. Qualifying organizations are urged to apply.

Rockcastle County has distributed Emergency Food and Shelter funds previously with Daniel Boone Development. This agency was responsible for providing 300 nights loding and provided utilities for more han 30 families


