The program is sponsored nationally by Six Flags Theme Parks, who provide free passes to their parks for every student raising \$35.00 or more.

The students who participate in

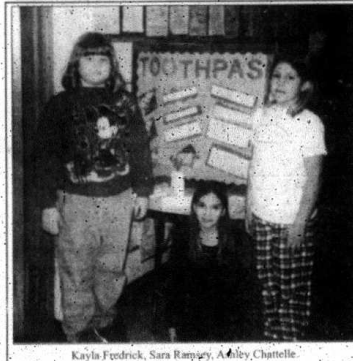
the program learn to do more than just math problems; they also learn the importance of helping children who are less fortunate than themselves. Through the Math-A-Thon, they are able to help provide a future for St. Jude Children's Research Hospital. Children with more than 700 forms of cancer and other catastrophic diseases find hope at St. Jude. Since its founding in 1962 by Dr. E. A. Hasenauer, Danny Thomas, the survival rate for most forms of pediatric cancer have risen dramatically. In fact, today more than 70% of all children with cancer will survive their bout with the disease. St. Jude fully credits these successes in treatment to the generous support of people around the world, including the students at Broadhead Elementary school.

"We are very proud of our students for working so hard on the Math-A-Thon," said Ms. Caroline Graves, volunteer coordinator. "With their help, St. Jude Hospital will be able to create new treatments that may one day lead to a cure for many forms of cancer that will benefit the children at our state, our country, and around the world. I also want to extend our thanks to the Broadhead community for supporting our students. It takes all of us to make a difference in the lives of children with cancer, and we can all feel proud of our response."
