

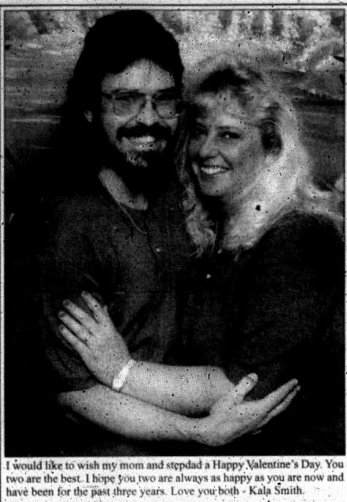


Rush - Little
