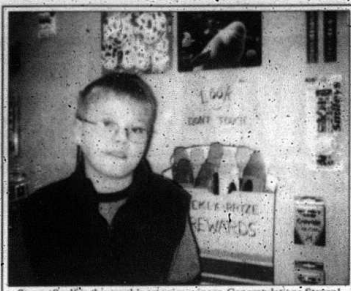
Sowder promoted in U.S. Air Force
