The decision to close this program was a difficult one to make. It was based on the findings from research conducted over the last five years of the program's existence. It was found that during that time frame, there has been a 46% decrease in the length of stay per family at the Family Life Services Facility. In addition, the average daily attendance had decreased by 39% and total resident days hid decreased by 40%. It was these findings that led CAP to conclude that the seld for the kinds of services offered by the program were not as prevalent as in years past. It is believed, that these decreased as religious to the conclusion of the self-order to low income families through the Welfare Reform Act.


