ARPA added a requirement that owners of farms for which a burley tobacco quota is established must report acreage planted to burley to-bacco annually including instances in which the acres planted are zero acres.

The 2001- ACT directs the Secretary to make direct payments to otherwise eligible persons on farms for which the quantity of quotas is eligible tobacco allotted to the farm was reduced from 1999 crop year to the 2000 crop year without regard to planted or considered planted credit for the 2000 crop year.
