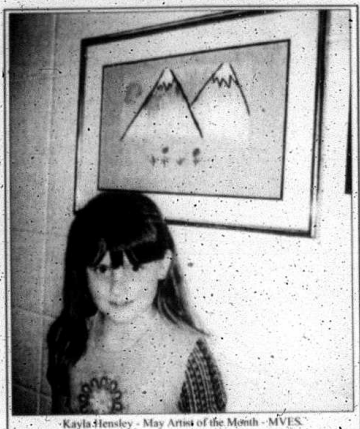

Charles Matthew Ford of Mt. Vernon, received a Bachelor of Science degree from the University of Maryland at Baltimore.

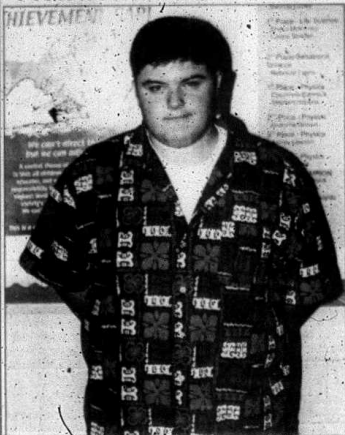
David Lynn King of Mt. Vernon, received a Bachelor of Science degree.
