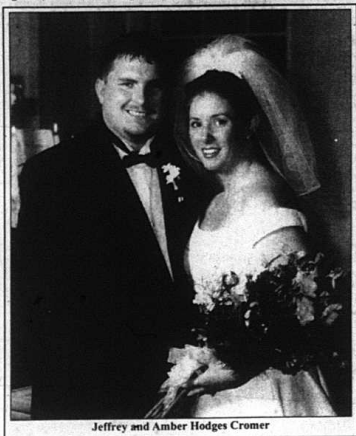




Jeffrey and Amber Hodges Cromer
