In 1987, we had about 10 children. The year the children picked the colors, orange and white, and the name, Hot Rods.


In 1988, I put an advertisement in the Signal for three, four, and five-yearolds to play Hot Rods.


In the fifteen years that I have done this, the Hot Rods have had many good spon-sors. I would like to thank all of them for helping me meet the expenses and keeping the


For the Bittersweet Festival Parade, let's see how many former Hot Rods we or walk in the parade.


