

David Pelzer guest speaker at District Day for school system

The Annual District Day for the Rockcastle County School System will be on August 14, 2001, in the Rockcastle County High School Auditorium. Registration will begin at 8 a.m., and the program will start at 8:30 a.m.

Our guest speaker will be David Pelzer. Dave has experienced a truly extraordinary life. As a child, he endured the horrors of child abuse, which included physical torture, mental cruelty, and near starvation. At age 12, Dave was rescued and placed in foster care until he enlisted in the U.S. Air Force at age 18. As a young adult, he was determined to better himself no matter what the odds.

Some of Dave's distinctive accomplishments have been recognized through a number of awards, as well as personal commendations from Presidents Reagan, Bush, and Clinton. In 1990, he was the recipient of the J.C. Penney Golden Rule Award, making him the California Volunteer of the Year. In 1993, Dave was honored as one of the Ten Outstanding Young Americans. He joins a distinguished group of alumni, who includes: John F. Kennedy, Richard Nixon, Anne Bancroft, Orson Welles, Walt Disney, and Nelson Rockefeller. In 1994 Dave was the only American to be honored as The Outstanding Young Persons of the World. He also carried the coveted Centennial Flame for the 1996 Olympics.

Dave's first book, "A Child Called It", was nominated for the Pulitzer Prize. Dave is one of the only authors to have three books simultaneously on the New York Times Best Sellers List and the first author to have two books simultaneously on this list in trade paperback. All three

books are highly acclaimed throughout the world. Dave's incredible life's story was featured on The Montel Williams Show, Sally Jesse, and Barbara Walters' The View.

Dave is one of the few personalities who pays homage to educators, social services, foster care, law enforcement, and volunteers—those who make a difference in the lives of children. He offers programs for human services, youth-at-risk, and corporate groups. Dave's experience includes: Juvenile Hall Counselor, Youth Service Worker, Troy State University-human services studies, National advisor-Missing Youth Foundation, Board of Directors-Foster Care ILP, and Certified Correctional Custody Program Facilitator.
