Now you can point and click to find out most anything you need to know about Rockcastle Hospital and Respiratory Care Center, Inc. Just log on to www.rockcastlehospital.org for information about the hospital's doctors, services and referral processes.

The site is an extension of the hospital's ongoing effort to increase the community's access to healthcare and health information. In addition, the highly specialized respiratory care services offered by RHRCC are available in only a few facilities in this section of the United States, so referrals from across the nation have increased.

RHRCC staff determined that a presence on the Web would make the referral process easier for other hospitals and agencies that are searching

for these services and want to send patients to Mt. Vernon for care.

"We have patients coming here from all over the country now, and some of them have had a hard time finding us," said Carolyn Stevens, director of Social Services. "Now

that we have a strong presence on the Internet, that should change."

The site is easy to navigate and offers links to many state and national organizations such as the American Heart Association, National Institutes of Health and Kentucky Organ Donor Affiliates. Additionally, employment information and a downloadable job application are available online.

"We want to make it simple for people in Rockcastle County, or anywhere in the country, to get the information they need about the hospital,"

said Lee Keene, president and CEO. "Today, the best way to do that is being on the Internet."

RHRCC staff along with Wiser, Hemlepp and Associates and Gilbert Design, both of Lexington, developed the Web site.

"We have greatly enhanced the hospital's use of technology during the past several years in order to increase efficiency and effectiveness," said Maleigha Amyn, manager of Information Systems. "Launching a Web site is an important step in accomplishing our technology plan."

Rockcastle Hospital and Respiratory Care Center, Inc. is a not-for-profit community hospital, which is accredited by the Joint Commission on Accreditation of Healthcare Or-

ganizations. It operates inpatient and outpatient acute care programs, 60 long-term beds for ventilator-dependent patients, and a home health care service. The hospital was established in 1956 and treats patients from across Kentucky, Tennessee and several other states.

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
