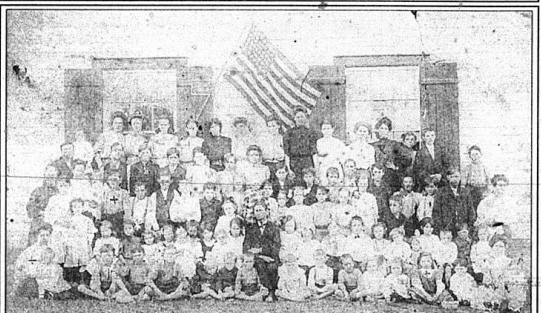

September 22nd - an outing to Cumberland Falls for a picnic and horseshoe riding.

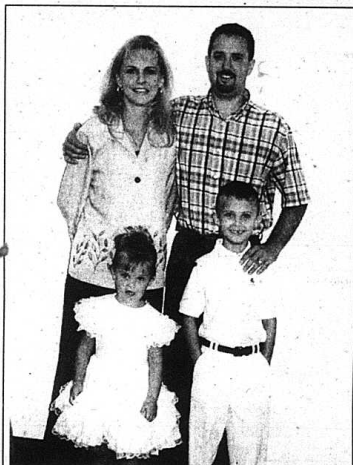
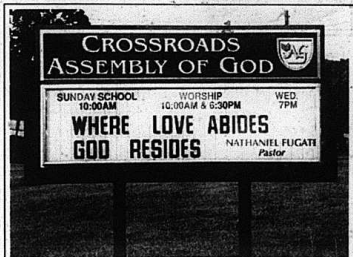
October 13th - Fish Fry and Gospel Singing - Fish Fry starting at 4:00 p.m. and singing at 7:00 p.m.
