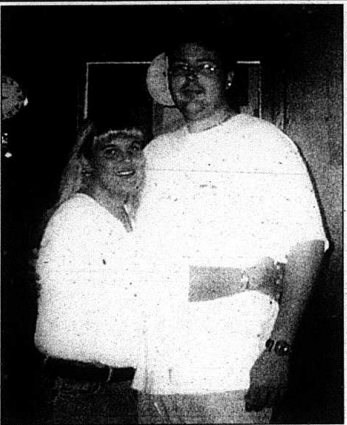




Hatmaker - Erwin

The wedding will be September 22, 2001 at 2 p.m. at Brush Creek Holiness Church. Friends and family are welcome to attend.

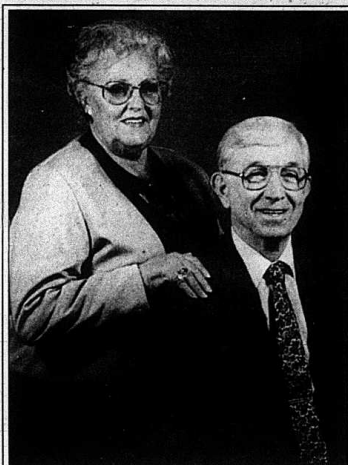

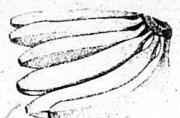
