On September 11, 2001, four airplanes were highcack by 19 terrorists.

to world trade Center. 8:45AM. About 15 minutes later a second plane crashed into the second tower of the World Trade Center. About a half hour after that, one of the planes crashed in the Pentagon. And a half hour after this, the 4th plane crashed into a field in rural western Pennsylvania. The death toll is over 6000 as of time of this writing. I think there are several lessons to observe about the tragic events that

took place.

1. The Uncertainties of Life. The Uncertainties of Life.

Ames points out to us the brevity and the uncertainty of life. "Go to now, that say, To day or to morrow we will go into such a city, and continue there a year, and buy and sell, and get gain. Whereas ye know not what shall be on the morrow. For what so your life? It is even a vapour, that speareth for a little time, and then vanisheth away." I wonder how many thought as they got up that morning, went to the airport, went to work at the World Trade Center, or went to the Pentagon, that that would be the study of their life? Who has a guaranteed promise of life tomorrow? Do any of us have a "lease on life"?

2. Run for Safety. In watching the video on TV, of people in the area when the building collapsed in New York, you could see people running, trying to escape the dust and smoke as it would come around a building like a huge monster. Then the dust came from another way, and their people turn to run in a different di-rection. Yet they did not escape. This is a perfect illustration of the neturn of Christ.
