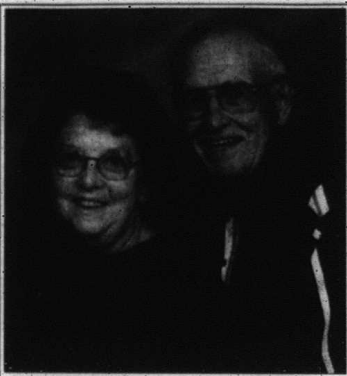




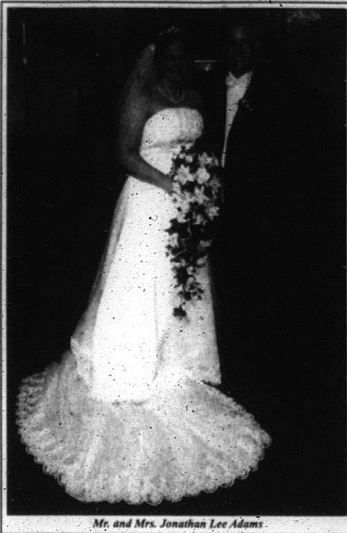
51st Wedding Anniversary
