Any person violating, or failing or refusing to comply with KRS 258.135(1), shall, upon conviction, be fined not less than five dollars (\$5) and not more than one hundred dollars (\$100) or be imprisoned for not less than five (5) nor more than sixty (60) days, or both, so fined and imprisoned.
