Said property being more particularly bounded and described as follows:

Tract #1: A tract of land situated near Wabod on Shaggs Creek in Rockcastle county, Ky., and bounded as follows: Beginning at a stake in the Mt. Vernon Somerset road; thence N 65 4/5 E 1 1/6 poles to a large white oak on the east side of the road; R.L. Bray's corner; thence with his line N 73 2/3 E 7 3/8 poles to a stone in Bray's line; thence a division line between L.M. Norton and E.B. Vernon and Somerset road opposite the center of a gate; thence with the road N 60 4 1/2 poles, N 28 1/2 poles and 23 links; thence N 15 1/2 E 19 1/2 poles to the beginning and contains 79 acres and 17 sq. rods.

Tract One: Approximately eight acres, lying on the West side of old U.S. Highway 461, this being all of the real property of the parties on the West side of old Highway 461.

Tract Three: The remaining acreage lying on the east side of new U.S. Highway 461 and being all of the real property of the parties on the East side of new Highway 461.
