The Transportation Cabinet, Department of Highways, has scheduled a Public Informational Meeting to give ALL interested persons an opportunity to view the right of way plans for the US 150 RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT FROM CRAB ORCHARD TO BRODHEAD. This project begins west of Crab Orchard near Deep Well Road and extends southeast to George Jones Road west of Brodhead.

The format of the meeting will be OPEN HOUSE from 5 pm to 7 pm (come and go as you please). The public will be able to view maps of the right of way plans.

Both oral and written statements may be submitted during the Meeting, as well as at the District Office, and shall be made part of the official Meeting record. For convenience, a comment sheet will be provided for soliciting written comments, and a recorder will be made available for those who desire to make oral statements. Statements will also be accepted and project information made accessible for review from 8:00 A.M. to 4:30 P.M., ET, Monday through Friday at the District Office up to fifteen (15) days after the Public Meeting.

Once compiled, the transcript from this Meeting and/or other supporting documentation will be made available for review and copying only after an Open Records Request has been received and approved. All Open Records Requests must be submitted to the Transportation Cabinet, Department of Administration Services, State Office Building, Frankfort, Kentucky 40622.

Your attendance and participation in this meeting is encouraged, welcomed, and essential. Members of the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet will be present to answer questions.
