4% of the premiums actually collected within each calendar quarter by
reason of the issuance of such policies on risks located within the County
of Rockcastle on those classes of business which such company is authorized to transact, less all-premiums returned to policyholders. No fee
shall be levied on premiums received for insuring employers against liability for personal injuries to employees, or the death of employees, caused,
thereby, under the provisions of the Worker's Compensation Act. Furthermore, there shall be no fee upon any company's life insurance and/or
health insurance policies on the lives of persons residing within the jurisdiction of the County of Rockcastle. Life and health policies are exempted.
