Kentucky Fair and Exposition Center in Louisville. March 1 and 2. Chris has owned his craft business for three years and is participating in this exciting Market for the first time.

The Market will feature 300 Kentucky exhibitors of contemporary and traditional crafts, two-dimensional visual art, books, musical recordings and food products, along with

children's craft activities and cultural entertainment. New this year is an exciting gallery section for juried participants and visual artists with unique, one-of-a-kind or limited-production items that will feature 42 exhibitors.



For the eighth year, The Market has been selected as one of the top twenty events in the southeast by the Southeast Tourism Society. Kentucky still holds the distinction of being one of the few states in the country to sponsor a wholesale/retail show for its craft businesses. "As the primary activity of the Craft Marketing Program, it serves as a major sales outlet for Kentucky businesses and generates two to three million dollars in sales annually," said Fran Redmon, Kentucky Craft Marketing program director.
