Selfishly, I hope it will be many years from now. So my children and their children will get to "Know and Love You."

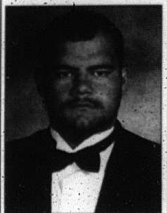
Each call we make to each other, ends in "I Love You."

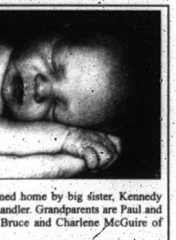
