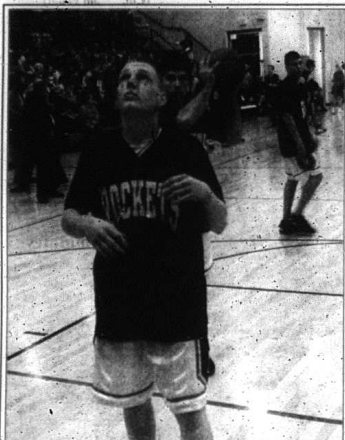




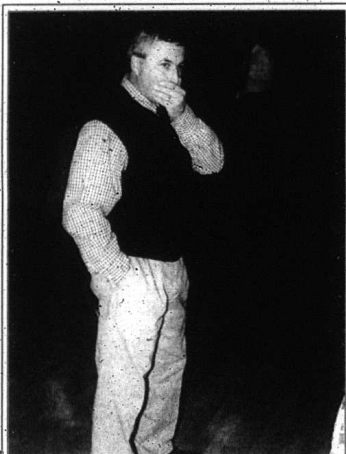

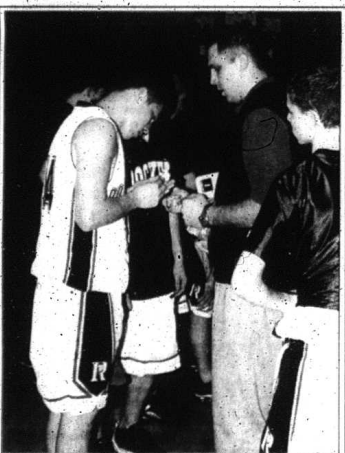

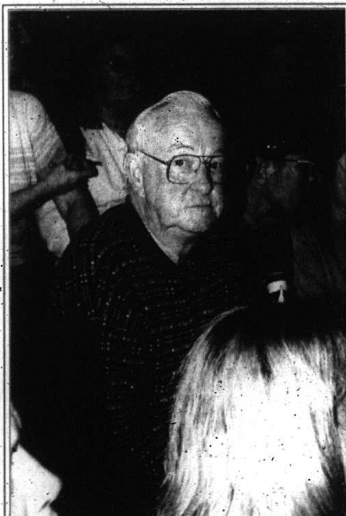

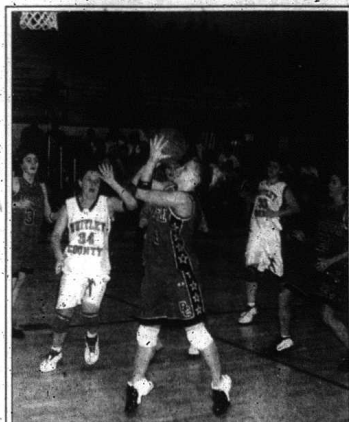

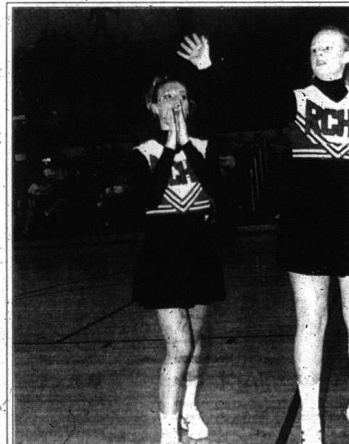
Rockcastle resident and Pastor Luke Lykins gave the invocation before Saturday night's regional final at Whitley County.
