She would pick up the trimmings, from the first cut, work them back into the original dough, then old out another cut, etc. until she had 6 or 8 layers', and any dough left over she let mad any other kid banging around eat raw. (No candy very fasted better) She holied anothe-saice which she

eat raw. (100 She boiled apple-sauce which she had canned by the dozens of jars from old horse apples and Grimes Goldens there on the place and spiced it with

the same stuff she had put in the dough except she used sugar, preferably brown if she had, it, instead of molasses to sweeten the sauce.
