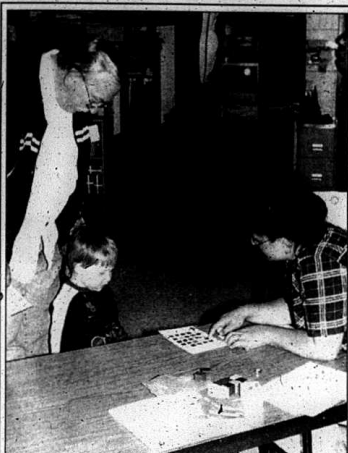




55th Wedding Anniversary

Pursuant to a judgment and order of sale entered in this partition action on April 11, 2003, for the purpose of satisfying the judgment against the defendants in the amount of Thirty Three Thousand Two Hundred Seventy One Dollars and 34/100 (\$33,271.34) plus interest, costs and attorney fees. I will offer at public auction the hereinafter described real property in Rockcastle County, Kentucky.

Said property being more particularly bounded and described as follows:

PARCEL NO. 1

Tract #1: Beginning at a large white oak near A.B. Thomson's house; thence S 50 W 30 poles to a stone corner to W.C. Thomson and A.B. Thomson; thence N 50 W 16 feet to a small locust corner to same parties in James Pittman's line to a rail fence; thence with the fence and Pittman's line; thence N 15 W 48 poles to a lynx under a cliff corner to W.C. Thomson and A.B. Thomson and Mullins' line; at the end of an old rail fence; thence S 40 E 41 poles to the beginning, and containing seven and one-half (7 1/2) acres; more or less.

Beginning at an iron pin at a point near the Bussell private road; thence N 25 deg. 33' 46" E a distance of 159.25 to an iron pin; thence S 61 deg. 19' 12" E a distance of 93.94 to an iron pin; thence S 34 deg. 19' 55" W a distance of 179.11 to an iron pin; thence N 45 deg. 27' 37" W a distance of 70.32 to an iron pin and the point of beginning and containing 0.14 acre, by survey of Gary W. Holman, Registered Land Surveyor #1837.

Being the same real property which Johnny Dooley obtained by deed dated December 11, 1998, executed by Kevin Wilson, et al, of record in Deed Book 172, page 411 in the office of the Rockcastle County Clerk.

THE PROPERTY SHALL BE SOLD UPON THE FOLLOWING TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

1. The above-described real property shall be sold together.
2. The real property shall be sold for cash or upon a credit of sixty (60) days with the purchaser required to pay a minimum of twenty five percent (25%) of the purchase price in cash on the date of sale and to secure the balance with a bond approved by the Master Commissioner.
3. The bond shall bear interest at the rate of twelve percent (12%) per annum until paid in full. The bond shall have the force and effect of a judgment and shall be and remain a lien upon the property sold as additional security for the payment of the purchase price.
4. The sale shall be subject to all real property and unpaid ad valorem taxes assessed for the fiscal year 2003 and all subsequent years.
5. Unpaid taxes or liens of record at the time of entry of judgment shall be paid out of the proceeds of the sale.
6. The purchaser shall have possession of the real property upon compliance with the terms of the sale.
7. In the event that the plaintiff is the successful bidder and the sale price does not exceed the amount of the plaintiff's judgment, no deposit or bond shall be required.
