FOR THE PROPERTY TAX ASSESSMENT ROLL.

Kockcastle County real property tax roll will be opened for inspect of the property valuation administrator or one of the dep

The taxpayer can appeal his assessment by filing in person or sending a letter or other written petition stating for appeal, identifying the property and stating the taxpayer's opinion of the fair cash value of the property.

Appeals of personal property assessments shall not be made to the county board of assessment appeals. Personal parapayers shall be served notice under the provisions of KRS 132.450(d) and shall have the protest and appeal granted under the provisions of KRS 131.110.

- He must list under protest (for certification) what he believes to be the fair cash value of his
- He must file a written protest directly with the Department of Property Valuation within 30 days from the date of the notice of assessment. (2)
- This protest must be in accordance with KRS 131.110.
- The final decision of the Revenue Cabinet may be appealed to the Kentucky Board of Tax App
