If you are considering or planning to enroll your child in Preschool, Head Start, or Kindergarten next fall, you need to register early!

PLEASE BRING YOUR CHILD'S BIRTH CERTIFICATE AND SOCIAL SECURITY CARD

WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO ATTEND?

- Priority 1:** any child age three (upon birth date) or four who has an identified disability
- Priority 2:** any child who is age four before or on October 1st, AND qualifies for free lunch
- Priority 3:** any other child who is four before or on October 1st, and resides within the attendance zone will be eligible as space permits
- Priority 4:** A qualifying child who is four before or on October 1st and resides outside the school attendance zone may attend another school, pending principal approval, if the parent provides transportation.
- Priority 5:** A non-qualifying child who is four before or on October 1st and resides outside the school attendance zone may attend another school, pending principal approval based on "hardship" if the parent provides transportation.
