Cumberland College honored several outstanding students Monday, April 28, during the Honors Day convocation service. Honors Day, held annually in the O. Wayne Rollins Center on the Cumberland College campus, recognizes students who have excelled academically throughout the school year.

Gretchen Phelps, daughter of Phillip and Gilda Phelps of Mt. Vernon, was the recipient of the George I. Alden Endowed Hall Scholarship. Only six students are chosen, based on their grade point average, leadership abilities and academic achievements.
