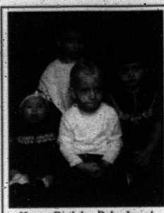

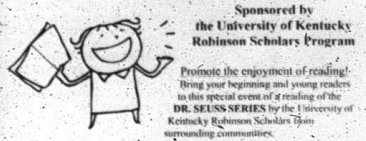

Kentuckians have an unprecedented chance to rebuild the state's school system and local boards are central to the reform movement. Share a sense of pride with other citizens by serving the children of Rockcastle County.

You are invited to nominate yourself, or a qualified acquaintance, to serve on the Rockcastle County Board of Education, representing Board Division I. There is a vacancy, created by the resignation of Samuel T. Stallworth.

Board members are involved in four main tasks:

- Developing policy-making guidelines that govern the operation of schools
- Providing visionary leadership and vigorous stewardship with long range educational plans and programs
- Hiring the district superintendent and issuing annual evaluation reports
- Setting local tax rates and ensuring that public funds are spent wisely and efficiently

Requirements:

- At least 24 years old
- Kentucky citizen for the last three years
- Registered voter in Division I
- High school diploma or GED certificate
- Except in limited circumstances, board members may not have a relative employed by the school district

Pick up an application at the Rockcastle County Board of Education office at 245 Richmond Street, Mt. Vernon, Ky. Mail the completed form to Gene Wilhoit, Commissioner of Education, 500 Metro Street, First Floor, Capital Plaza Tower, Frankfort, Ky. 40601. Applications must be postmarked by July 31, 2003.
