were obedient and in returned received blessings as did the camp. This group cut down trees (got a few bee stings), collected rocks, planted flowers, groomed the grounds, and painted. They did these tasks with a servant's heart. One of the teenagers, Justin Ahlgren, said, "I realized how pointless it is to complain when you're serving for Christ. I mean seriously, how can I complain with a seat in heaven and a changed life?" What insight at a young age!

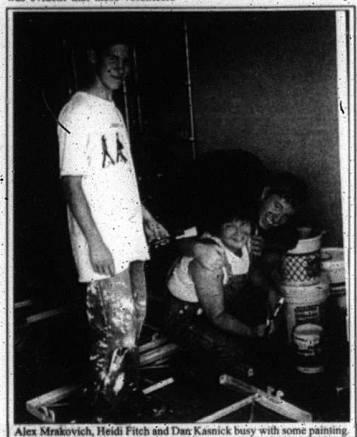
