Loan Deficiency Payment (LDF)
For a commodity to be eligible for

For a commodity to be eligible for a loan or a loan deficiency paymen (LDP), the producer must have ben-eficial interest in the commodity in addition to other eligibility require-

nents.

For LDPs, the producer must reain beneficial interest in the comnodity eligible from the time of harest through the date the LDP is requested. For loans, the producer must
retain beneficial interest in the com-

retain beneficial interest in the com-modity. from the time of harvest through the date the loan is redeemed or Commodity Credit Corporation (CGC) takes title to the commodity. Changes to the 2002 Farm Bill permit all producers to be eligible regardless if the farm is participat-ing.

For commodities immediately fed during harvest, the producer must complete a CCC-709, Part E within 60 calendar days after the date of harvest.

All loans or LDPs requested shall be subject to a determination by CCC of such producers eligibility to receive a loan or an LDP, based on a review of any option to purchase of Aules contract involving the commodity.

As a condition of eligibility for re-ceiving price support, all pesticide products (including plant regulators, defoliants and desiccants) used in connection with the production of Burley tobacco, must be approved by the Environmental - Protection Agency (EPA) for use on tobacco and that such sesticide products must be applied in accordance with label di-rections.

For purposes of the pesticide certification program, the term "pesticide" means "any substance or mixture of substances intended for preventing, destroying, repelling or mingating any pest, and any substance
or mixture of substances intended for
use as a plant regulator, defoliant or
desiccant."

Action to withhold price support on tobacco treated with nonapproved EPA pesticides or when pesticides are not used in accordance with Label directions was made necessary because their use threatens the domestic and stores markets for tobacco.
