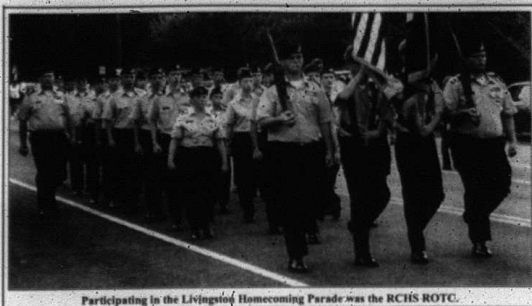

## "Illegal Dumping" (Cont. From Front)

In an August 22nd letter to Estill Rose of London, Carlotta informed Mr. Rose that he would be charged \$334.76 for landfill costs and an up charge of \$448 for use of county equipment in the clean-up is being forgiven and Mr. Rose is being allowed to make repayment in ten consecutive monthly installments.

Rose is also being required to provide proof of solid waste curbside collection by his household in Laurel County and to publish and advertisement in newspapers in London, Mt. Vernon and Berea noting that Rockcastle County does not tolerate illegal dumping and admitting to poor judgment and negligent actions. Carlotta said that Rose was vouched for by a Laurel County attorney and that there were mitigating circumstances in that the clutch on Mr. Rose's truck went out on the day of the incident.
