Gillum announces new drug court for Rockcastle and Pulaski

Circuit Judge Robert E. Gillum has announced the establishment of a Drug Court Program to enable Pulaski and Rockcastle Counties to participate in the \$1.1 million dollars appropriated by Congress for the establishment of drug courts in the 5th Congressional District. Judge Gillum and Judge William T. Cain will devise rules for the program which they expect to be fully implemented in January, 2004.

Fifth District Congressman Hal Rogers and Chief Justice of the Kentucky Supreme Court Joseph Lambert have been instrumental in the development and funding of the Drug Court concept. "Traditionally, non-violent drug offenders are incarcerated with little or no opportunity for substance abuse treatment. The Drug Court Program provides judges with the means to apply court-supervised treatment and education to promote a positive life change for non-violent drug offenders. Additionally, it provides the full range of punishment for those who fail to comply with the treatment program."
