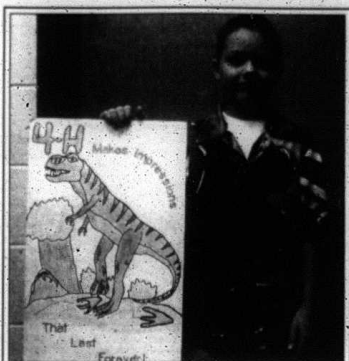




More coupons for Seniors

Seniors should visit the Rockcastle Co. Senior Citizens Center located on Hwy 25 South, next to Lumber King. Sherry Mowbray will assist participants in completing forms and issue additional coupons. Local farmers markets will continue to operate on Wednesdays at Brodhead Fairgrounds and Saturdays at Remick Valley through early October. Farmers continue to have fresh beans, corn, tomatoes and cabbage. Fall items such as apples, potatoes and sweet potatoes are coming on and should be available until October 25. "It Is Written"

Last week we discussed the proper mode of baptism, a burial or immersion in water. Today we want to talk about the proper purpose of baptism as given in the scriptures. Let's begin in the great commission, in Mark 16:15-16: "And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved: but he that believeth not shall be damned." Thus we see that baptism is a condition of salvation as is believing. In Acts 2:38, "Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost." Here we see that baptism and repentance are conditions for the remission of sins (or for salvation). In Acts 22:16, Paul was told, "And now why tarriest thou? arise, and be baptized, and wash away thy sins, calling on the name of the Lord." Here we see that one was told that baptism is required to have your sins washed away, (or salvation) Baptism is a condition of salvation, just like faith, repentance, and confession are conditions of salvation. We must comply with all of God's commands to live, Matt 4:4. All these steps are commanded by Jesus, not me or some group of church of Christ preachers! Friends, have you obeyed Jesus?

4-H Poster Contest underway

The Rockcastle Co. 4H Poster Contest is getting up in each of our county's elementary schools. Each year the students are given an opportunity to demonstrate their creativity by competing in the contest. The following rules must be met in order to qualify.

1. Poster must be created by a currently enrolled 4H'er.
2. Well known cartoon figures cannot be used because they are copyrighted. (Examples: Looney Tunes, Sponge Bob-Square Pants, Blues-Clues, Mickey Mouse, Star Wars, Spiderman, Charlie Brown, Pooh, etc.)
3. All posters must be designed on, or affixed to, .016 ply construction paper, poster board (solid fiber board) of 14 inch x 22 inch dimensions (one-half a standard poster board size). They may be horizontal or vertical. Posters may be produced by any medium, such as, watercolor, ink, crayon, acrylic, charcoal, oils, or collage, as long as they are not three dimensional.
4. 4H is to be the topic for the poster. You can show what you think 4H is; what you do in 4H, or what you think 4H does for young people.
5. The 4H'er name, age, FULL MAILING ADDRESS, county, teacher, school and grade must be affixed to the back of the poster.

boards in the upper left hand corner. 6. Winners will be chosen by grade. 4, 5, 6, 7, & 8. Posters are due on October 17, 2003. The first and second place winners will receive a plaque. Third place winners will receive blue ribbons.

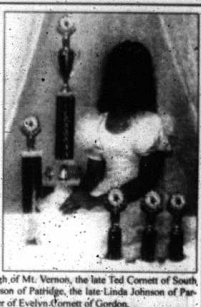
