livestock Assistance Program

livestack Assistance Program (LAP)
Rockeastle County has been added to the counties as being approved for the Livestock Assistance Program for the 2001 crop year.
To be eligible for LAP, the county must have suffered at least a 40 percent grazing loss for three or more consecutive months in: a calendar year. A producer may receive a LAP payment on a per head basis of chigible livestock when the producer has control of adequate grazing land to support the eligible livestock include: bee' fallowing and dairy, catile, buffalo, beefalio, sheep, goots, swime and other certain equine.

goats, ware successfully a divestock producer must have stiffered a 40 percent or greater loss of grazing production for three or more consecutive months due to drought, hot weather, disease, insect infestation, flood, fire, hurri-caine, earthquake, severe storm or other natural diseaster.
