Pursuant to a judgment and order of sale entered in this action on August 4, 2003, for the purpose of dividing the proceeds among the parties according to their interest, I will offer at public auction the hereinafter described real property in Rockcastle County, Kentucky.

Said property being more particularly bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at an ash stump on a high point on the east side of Scaffold Branch, same being Kidwell's corner, and with his line bearing N 76 W 14 chains, crossing Scaffold Branch, to a stone near the head of a drain; thence S 20 1/2 W 6.25 chains to a white oak on a point about 50 yards from Henry Cook Spring Branch, old Brook corner; thence S 82 1/2 W 156 chains to a set stone in old Brook line; thence beginning a new line bearing S 34 3/4 E 4.18 chains to a set stone; thence S 11 1/4 E 9.25 chains to a set stone and Hickory pointer in edge of a road; thence N 78 W 3.86 chains to a Hickory; thence N 52 W 3.82 chains to a stake 0.08 chains North of a large white oak; thence N 83 W 5.20 chains to a Hickory (10 inches in diameter); thence S 87 3/4 E 2.29 chains to a set stone small sugar tree and buckeye pointers below a spring; thence S 58 1/2 W 2.00 chains to an ash (18 inch diameter) east of Fed Chimney; thence S 61 E 1.80 chains to a set stone below a rock pile and three small black walnuts; thence S 26 1/2 E 8.50 chains to a set stone 10 feet below a large apple tree; thence S 37 S small locust in line at 2.00 chains in all 8.10 chains to a set stone and large locust point in corner of field; thence S 62 E 9.00 chains to a stone; thence S 30 1/2 E 4.28 chains to the U.
