

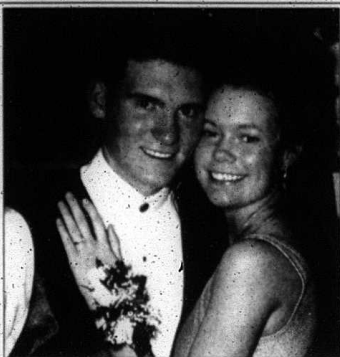

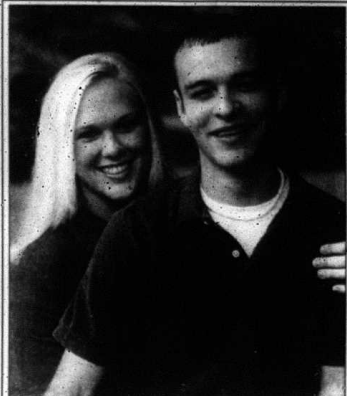
90th Birthday Celebration

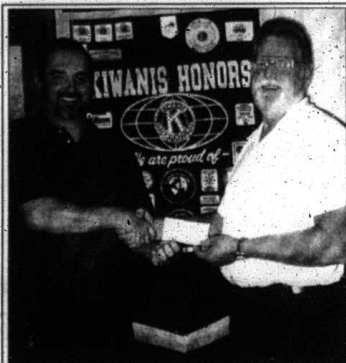
Bowles - Jones

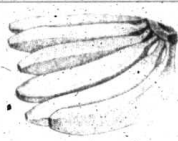

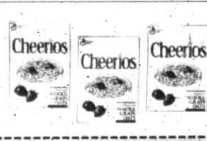
