and devotion times twice daily.

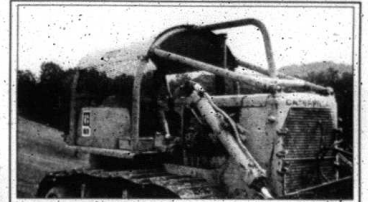
In addition, many of the youth and

tian Church.

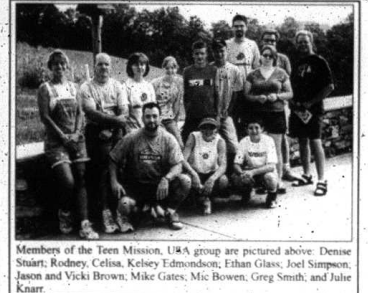
A member of this group played a
