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"It is Written"

The past few weeks we have been discussing the topic of baptism. We continue on this topic by looking at a text in Acts 19:1-5. And he said unto them, I am glad that ye have been baptized; but ye have not received the Holy Spirit. They said unto him, No, we have not. He said unto them, What have ye done? They said unto him, We have been baptized unto John's baptism. He said unto them, What baptism? They said unto him, The baptism of repentance, saying unto the people, that they should believe in him who should come after him: that is, on Christ Jesus. When they heard this, they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. Here we see people who were baptized unto John's baptism, but it was not longer valid; so they were baptized unto Jesus' baptism. What we can learn today is that baptism is not to be "re-baptized" if they have not followed the truth of Jesus. If you have been baptized by sprinkling or pouring, such is according to the doctrine of men; you must needs be baptized in the scriptural fashion of immersion. Col. 2:12-13 If you were baptized to show that you were already saved, as many are taught. You must needs be baptized for the right reason. Act 2:38 for the remission of sins. If you were baptized to get someone off your back, or some other wrong motive, you must needs be baptized again, doing it from the heart, Rom. 10:10 Be sure you have done exactly what the Lord has said!
