Applications for paper absentee ballots must be received in the county clerk's office by October 28, 2003. Requests for applications must be made by phone, fax, mail or in person and can be requested by the voter or the spouse, parents or child of voter.

Absentee voting for voters who will be absent from the county on election day but according to law are not al-lowed to vote by paper absentee ballot will be conducted in the county clerk's office beginning October 20, 2003 through November 3, 2003. The hours for voting will be Monday through Friday 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. and on Saturdays from 8:30 a.m. to 12 noon.
